## SETAC Media Policy

### SETAC Media policy

In order to prevent disruptions and to ensure science-based discourse among speakers attendees, the following policy applies:

- There will be cameras allowed in, and/or radio broadcasts made directly from, the sessions with the express, advance approval of the SETAC Europe Executive Director
- Filming may be allowed in Poster Sessions (after having received permission from author), in the Press Room with consenting speakers, in the Plenary Sessions, an Exhibition Hall, with permission from the SETAC Europe Executive Director.
- Audio taping for re-broadcast of technical presentations or question-and-answer allowed with express, advance approval by the SETAC Europe Executive Director.
- A SETAC member or staff member may be assigned to news crews in order to familiarize them with the meeting layout, answer questions about the Society, and generally their work.
- All requests for filming, photographs, interviews, etc. outside this policy must be to the SETAC Europe Executive Director for a decision.

This policy is intended to engender a rational and professional forum in which science-based can be discussed. Any media representative who sells, markets, or represents a company for purposes of obtaining advertising or subscriptions from any exhibitor or registrant will forfeit press credentials for this and subsequent meetings.
